Experience ministry in a diverse urban environment:

Christ Church Cathedral in Houston is looking for three summer interns to act as guides and ambassadors for the CUSE program in 2020.

Time Frame:

- May 24 August 16
- Possibly a week in March (during intern's spring break)

Qualifications:

- US citizen or legal worker
- First Aid and CPR certification (you can get this after you're hired)
- Must have completed at least one year of college by May 2020
- Safeguarding God's Children training and background checks for the Diocese of Texas (you can complete training after you are hired)
- Must be a servant leader, capable of taking initiative
- Compassionate with excellent people skills
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) a plus but not necessary

Responsibilities:

- Provide orientation of Houston, Christ Church Cathedral, and CUSE to youth groups
- Serve as a liaison between service sites and visiting groups
- Guide groups to sites for service, food, and fun
- Maintain professional and be a voice for CUSE
- Help prepare the space and shop for each successive group
- Participate in the liturgical life of the Cathedral
- Other needs as they arise

- Training and supervision by Cathedral staff, also available for discernment
- METRO passes for local transport
- Competitive pay
